

Village of Highland  
Crackfilling and Sealcoat Bid Opening

On April 28, 2017 the Village of Highland Street Committee met at the village office to open bids for the 2017 street crackfilling and sealcoating. Street Committee Members Dennis Richgels and John Kreul started the meeting at 1:00 pm and public works operator Tom Hebgen was present at the meeting. Wayne Jerrett from Fahrner Asphalt and Carl Thorsen from Scott Construction were also present for the bid opening. Dennis and John instructed Tom to open the bids.

At this time the bids were opened as follows:

- Fahrner Asphalt – Sealcoat only:
  - Isabell St from Dodgeville St to Spring St – \$5,682.00
  - Dodgeville St from Kennedy St to Tower Rd – \$8,426.00
  - East Circle Drive – \$7,885.00
  - Varsity Lane – \$12,385.00
  - Total Bid – \$34,378.00.
- Scott Construction Inc:
  - Varsity Lane/Cardinal Dr – \$9,485.00
  - East Circle Drive – \$6,184.00
  - Dodgeville St from Kennedy St to Tower Rd – \$6,599.00
  - Isabell St from Dodgeville St to Spring St – \$4,998.00 (heavy seal)
  - Total Bid – \$27,266.00

Scott Construction submitted three bids and Carl asked the board to only open the sealcoat bid to compare bids with Fahrner's sealcoat only bid.

The Street committee informed the bidders that information would be brought to the May board meeting and a decision will be made at that time.

Wayne was thanked for his bid and he left the opening.

Carl talked with the street committee and Tom about doing less sealcoating and doing some crackfilling to do maintenance on more streets and come back later to finish sealcoating at a later date.
