

ORDINANCE 1995-4

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 AND CHAPTER 3
RELATING TO VILLAGE POLICE CHIEF OFFICE
AND POLICE DEPARTMENT**

The Village Board of the Village of Highland, Iowa County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain:

SECTION I: That Section 2.03 referring to the office of Chief of Police is hereby repealed.

SECTION II: Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 61.195 the office of Police Chief will be discontinued.

SECTION III: That Chapter 3 of the Village of Highland Municipal Code "Police and Civil Defense" relating to or referring to a Village police chief and police department, as created under Wis. Stats. Sec. 61.65 is hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: That in place of said Chapter 3 of the Village of Highland Municipal Code which is hereby repealed by the preceding paragraph, the Village Board of the Village of Highland does hereby reaffirm the balance of Chapters 2 and 3 of the Village of Highland Municipal Code and any other pertinent Code ordinances, and also reaffirms the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 61 providing for Village police authority. The statutory police authority provisions of the Marshall (sec.61.28), the Village President (sec. 61.24), the Trustees (sec. 61.32), Peace Officers (sec. 61.31, sub. 1) and the Clerk (61.25, sub.9) are reinstated.


SECTION V: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force following its adoption and posting as required by law.
