

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-11**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 13.05(6) AND TO CREATE SECTION 13.05(8) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND, IOWA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, RELATING TO ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSES**

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND, IOWA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section I:** Section 13.05(6) of the Municipal Code shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

**“13.05 APPROVAL OF APPLICATION**


- (6) Applications for temporary fermented malt beverage and/or wine licenses shall be approved by the Village Board and must be submitted at least one week prior to the Board meeting at which the approval sought will be acted upon by the Village Board.”

**Section II:** Section 13.05(8) of the Municipal Code shall be and hereby is created to read as follows:

- “(8) In the event any person seeking a temporary fermented malt beverage and/or wine license submits an untimely application, the Village President will review and deny or approve the license. The applicant shall submit the application and a \$50 fee to the Village Clerk for the temporary fermented malt beverage and/or wine licenses.”

**Section III:** This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and posting as required by law.
